## *From the Deacon's Laptop: I believe in the Holy Spirit*

As we continue the Year of Faith and the presentation of the Catechism, this article about the next section of the Creed, *I believe in the Holy Spirit*, provides the information of the mission He has been sent to fulfill.

Even though the Holy Spirit is the last person of the Trinity to be revealed, we must understand that, from the beginning, He is part of the loving plan of our salvation from sin and offer of divine life.

The Catechism also answers several questions about this subject.

**What is our faith regarding the Holy Spirit?** – In believing in the Holy Spirit we profess that the Holy Spirit is one of the persons of the Holy Trinity, consubstantial with the Father and the Son: "with the Father and Son he is worshipped and glorified" (CC 685)

**What are the images of the Holy Spirit in Scripture?** – In scripture, some of the images of the Holy Spirit are fire, cloud and light, seal, hand, fingers of God and a dove. (CCC 696-701)

**What are the ways the Holy Spirit provides us with an experience of God's presence?"** The Catechism sets out eight ways in which to experience the presence of God:

- When we pray and study the Scripture which the Holy Spirit inspired;
- When we read the lives of the saints;
- When we assent with obedience to the teaching of the Magisterium;
- When we actively participate in the liturgies and Sacraments of the Church;
- When we give ourselves to prayer, whether it is the rosary, the Liturgy of the Hours, meditation, or other prayers;
- When we offer ourselves to the various missionary or apostolic efforts of the Church;
- When we recognize the charismas and ministries that help build the Church;
- When we dwell on the great Traditions of the Church. (CC 688)

### **What are the gifts of the Holy Spirit?**

When a person receives the Sacrament of Confirmation, they also receive the seven gifts; wisdom, understanding, counsel, courage, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord. (CCC 1831)

The Holy Spirit builds up, animates, and sanctifies the Church. He prepares us to go out and bring others to Christ. He opens our minds to understand Christ's death and Resurrection. He makes present for us the mystery of Christ, especially in the Eucharist, and brings us to communion with God that we may bear much fruit. (CCC 737)

(Excerpt CCC 683-747)

### **Conclave 2013:**

#### ***How will a new Pope be chosen?***

Thursday marked the final day of Pope Benedict's XVI reign as the head of the Catholic church, and soon, the traditional conclave will gather to select a new Pope.

How, though, will that happen? And how long will it take? The shortest conclave only took a few hours, while the longest one took 3 years to pick a new leader.

Cardinals from around the world will descend on the Vatican and will be locked behind closed doors until they reach a two-thirds vote on a new Pope. Traditionally, the cardinals cast ballots, then burn them.

Later, chemicals were added to the smoke to change its color. Black smoke emitted from the chimney on top of the Sistine Chapel indicates that a Pope has not yet been chosen. However, when the iconic white smoke begins to rise, it's a signal to the world that they have a new Pope.

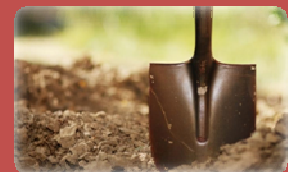

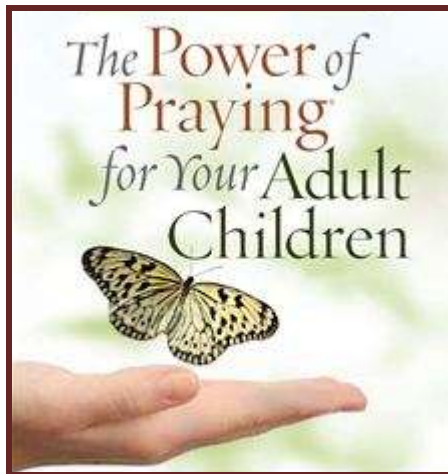
