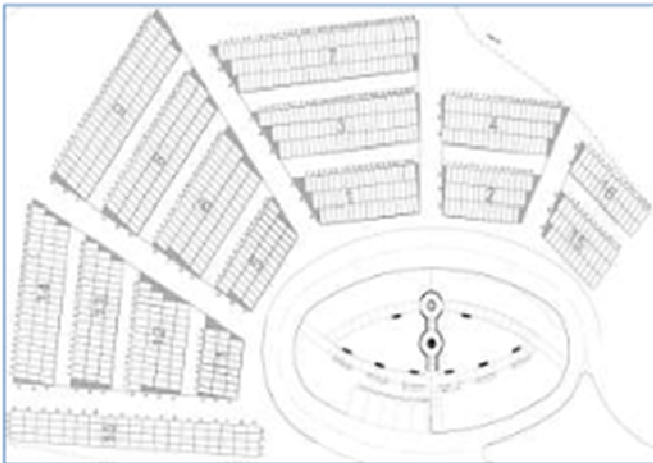

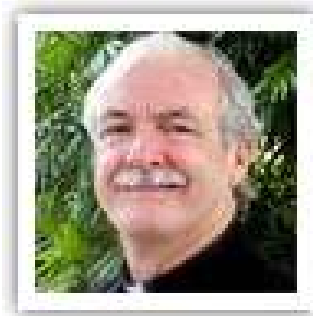
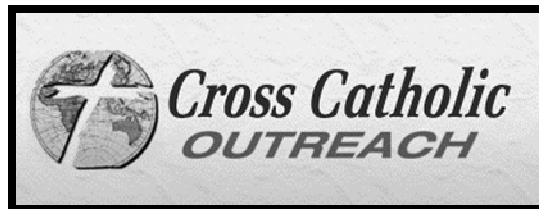

Father Richard Kunzman is a priest of the Diocese of Camden, NJ. He was ordained in 1963, He began his seminary education in the “Divinity School” at Seton Hall University in South Orange, NJ.

He continued his preparation for the Priesthood St. Mary's Seminary and University in Baltimore, MD. During his six years at St. Mary's he was awarded the A.B., S.T.B., and S.T.L. degrees in Theology. In 1962 he received his M.Ed. from Loyola University in Baltimore. He did Graduate Studies in Psychology at Temple University in Philadelphia, PA. In 1984 he received his doctorate in Pastoral Counseling (D.MIN) from Boston University in Boston, MA.

Father began as a high school teacher in Wildwood, NJ. He was then sent by the Camden Mission to serve in Brazil in the hospital ministry. Parish work, and as counselor at Catholic Social Services in the Camden Diocese. In 1980 Father began ministry at the New England Rehabilitation Hospital in Woburn, MA as the Director of Pastoral Care. As a member of the Boston Theological Institute he participated in the formation of seminary students in their efforts to qualify as hospital chaplains. This was an ecumenical adventure made up of both men and women. While in Boston he studied at Boston University where in 1984 he received a Doctorate in Pastoral Counseling (D. Min).

Returning home to Camden, he ministered full time with Catholic Social Services and the Family Life Bureau.

In the past 24 plus years he has preached in well over 1,100 parishes and today he serves the poorest of the poor for Cross Catholic Outreach.
