THE THIRD SCRUTINY AND THE LORD'S PRAYER

Since this is the Fifth Sunday of Lent we celebrate the third scrutiny, where after the Elect are given the Lord's Prayer to meditate on and we pray as a community. I want to share with you these elements of the Lord's Prayer that

inspire me.

There are 18 Elements in the **Prayer of Our Father**,

RELATIONSHIP	Our Father
RECOGNITION	Who art in Heaven
ADORATION	Hallowed be Thy Name
ANTICIPATION	Thy Kingdom come
OBEDIENCE	Thy will be done.
UNIVERSALITY	On earth
CONFORMITY	As it is in heaven
SUPPLICATION	Give us
DEFINITENESS	this day
NECESSITY	our daily bread
PENITENCE	and forgive us
OBLIGATION	our trespasses
FORGIVENESS	as we forgive
MERCY us	those who trespass against
GUIDANCE	and lead us
PROTECTION	not into temptation,
SALVATION	but deliver us
RIGHTEOUSNESS	From evil.

This great prayer that Jesus Himself gave to His disciples, is also referred to as a teaching. It is the "Lord's Prayer" in the sense that it came from Him, not that He prayed it Himself. Think about what a great lesson

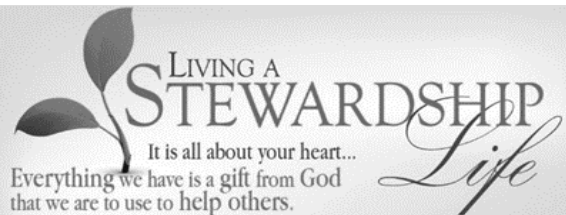
