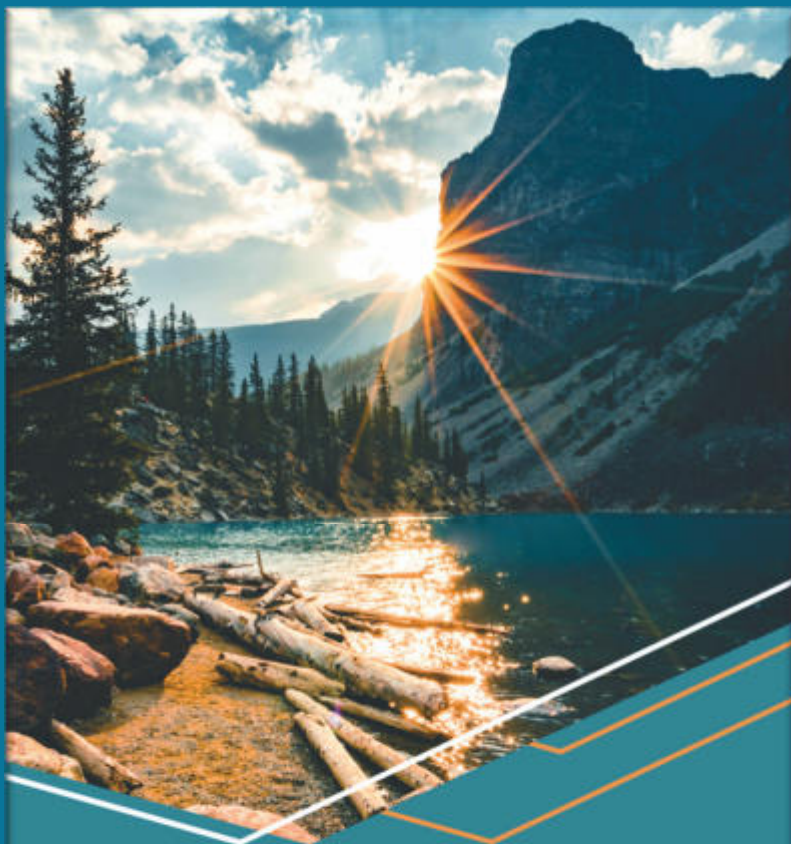

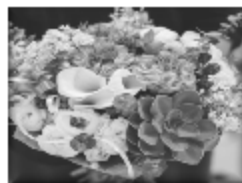

As our fiscal year closed on 6/30/20, we have much to be thankful for. Compared to last year, we are moving in the right direction. Our cash balance includes \$48,000 received as a loan from the Small Business Association. This loan may be forgiven, but if it is not, then we will begin to pay it back in November at 1% interest. Beginning July 1, we will begin to pay back our debt to the diocese by paying \$3000 a month. Hopefully next year we will increase that amount to reduce the debt faster. We have renegotiated our mortgage loan and we have a much lower monthly payment as of June 1st, thanks to the lower interest rates. The diocese debt will continue to decrease each month and no further debt from them should be necessary. We have decreased our total debt by about \$70,000 this year. Thank you for your help to achieve this goal.

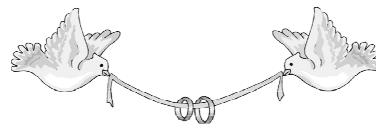
