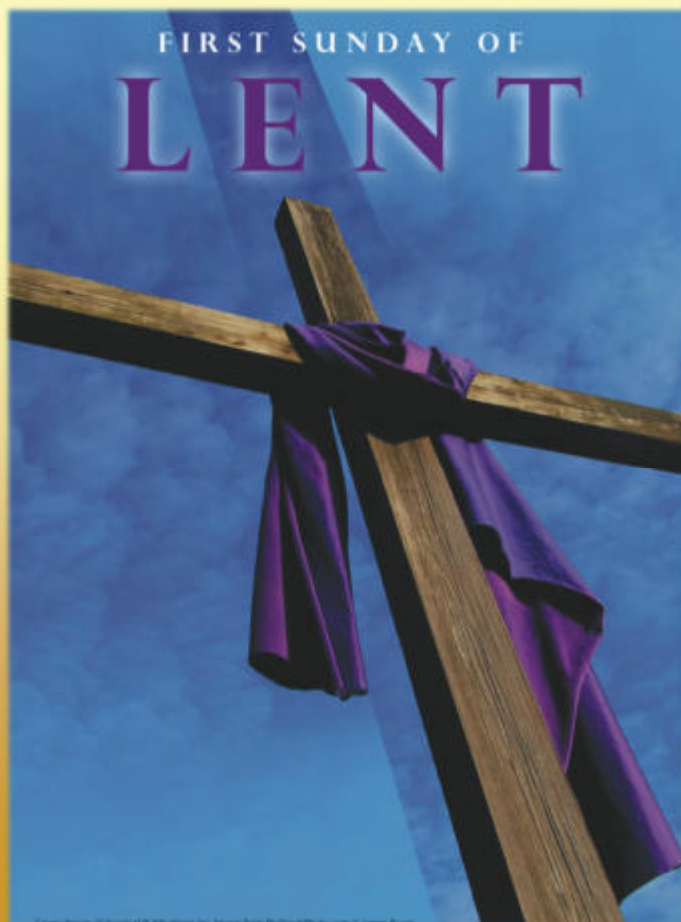

Dear Parishioners and fellow Pilgrims,

### Grace and Peace to you!

I would like to welcome you to the holy season of Lent 2021. Lent is a special time of God's Mercy and Grace, yet indeed God is always merciful, and always invites us to encounter his Grace for us as we continue on this journey, as pilgrims heading home.

There is a lot that tends to stand in the way, preventing us from reaching our destiny. It is the reason, God became man, and to lift us up, and lead us to Himself. Lent makes us reflect on the reality of sin, that stands in our way. On a more positive note though, Lent makes real our redemption through our Lord Jesus: the one who suffered and died to save us from the condemnation we incurred because of our sins. Lent puts us on a forty day journey that is climaxed with the celebration of Easter: The Resurrection of Jesus, who by that action of resurrecting conquered sin and death.

At Sts. Peter and Paul, and at St. Joseph, we are dedicating this Lent to a theme: **Fall and Redemption**. We are going to look at the reality that sin is real and that we are sinners. But more importantly and positively, we are going to look at Jesus redeeming us and lifting us from our sins through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. On this first Sunday of Lent, St. Joseph Church will have an opportunity to have its news Confessional blessed. This is being done in a more solemn way as a reminder that the Lord Jesus is always there and inviting us to reconcile with him, to save us.

We are providing more times for confessions during this time, and I would like to invite you all to look at our schedule and meet our Lord Jesus in this sacrament of Reconciliation. Please call the office or the rectory if you prefer to have special time for confession, and I will be very happy to bring you the Grace of Jesus through this Sacrament of Penance/Reconciliation.

And every Wednesday during Lent at 7pm, we shall have an opportunity for a 10 minute talk. Some parishioners will be sharing their joys of encountering Jesus in this holy Sacrament of Reconciliation. Please plan to tune in to our Facebook live, **Fall and Redemption**, and listen to this sharing.

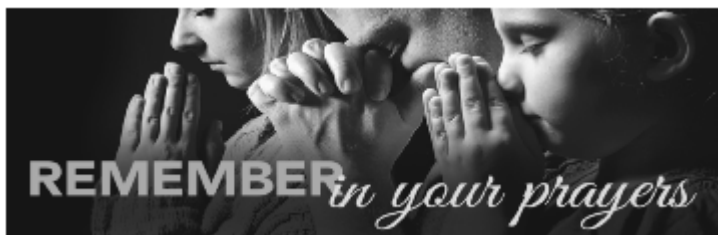

## The Unlikely Suspects

Have you ever taken a nature walk? Have you leisurely strolled through a forest or field, with no real destination in mind and your only objective being receptivity to and observation of all God's creation?

Sometimes, Scripture readings can feel like a nature walk. All of salvation history plays out against the backdrop of the natural world, with all elements of God's creation — plants and animals and the dust of the earth itself — turning in a supporting performance. How about Jesus in the hot and dusty desert, tempted, living "among the wild beasts?" Noah departed from his ark with the animals he rescued, observing God's sign in the very clouds of the sky. Even God Himself, offering us salvation from original sin through the waters of baptism.

How often do we remember that God speaks to us through all of His creation, even in the unlikely suspects?

Let's go back to the nature walk. It sounds like a lovely way to pass an afternoon, amongst wildflowers and butterflies, but don't forget the beating hot sun, mosquitos, and threat of rain on the horizon. Remember, we're not in heaven yet. Here on earth, God may be present in His creation, but that doesn't mean it's always easy to endure.

Lent is, essentially, a time to listen for the voice of God in places we may not expect: the mild irritations you experience when you're craving the chocolate you gave up, or the dull pangs of hunger during the Ash Wednesday fast. It's a golden opportunity to see the divine hand in all of creation, even those unlikely suspects.

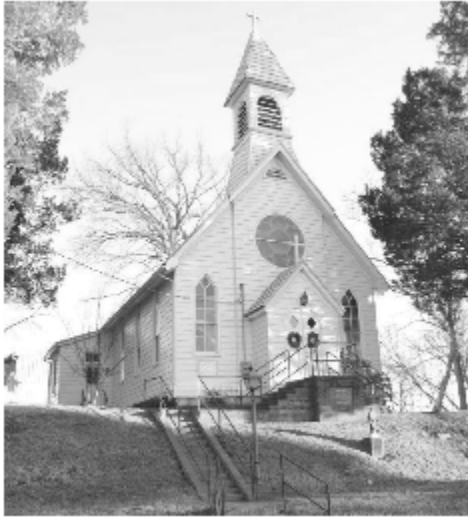

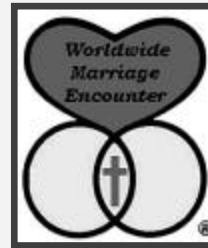
