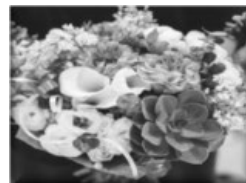

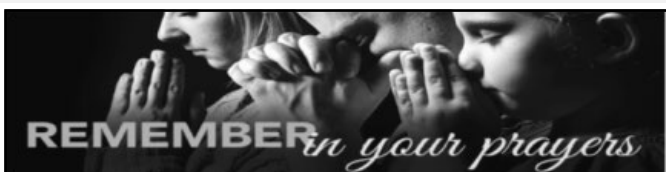



- * Over the past 100 years, the number of Catholics around the world has tripled from 291 million in 1910 to 1.1 billion in 2010. Percentage wise, the population has remained relatively stable, constituting 17% of the world population in 1910 and 16% in 2010.
- * While the cross is a predominant Catholic symbol, it actually greatly predates Christianity and is, in fact, one of the most ancient human symbols. It may be seen as the union of divinity (the vertical line) and the world (horizontal line.)
- * The Catholic Church is the largest charitable organization in the U.S.

A note from our Finance Chair:

When I addressed you in April, I reported that our finances were good. Collections ran slightly behind budget, but this was offset by savings in spending. Collections for debt reduction was on budget. June 30th concluded the parish fiscal year. Collections finished the year slightly below budget. Thanks in large part to Cynthia Aycock and her team of volunteers running the yard sale, fundraising income was above budget. Spending for the year was six percent below budget. Debt collection was slightly above budget. Consequently, Sts. Peter & Paul finished the fiscal year with a positive contribution. Thank you.

Another factor contributed to our success. In the spring Fr. David met with Bishop Barry Knestout and he requested debt relief from the diocese. I am pleased to inform you that Fr. David's efforts were successful. The dioceses agreed to forgive Sts. Peter & Paul \$25,000 of our diocesan debt. This will accelerate our retirement of debt to the diocese and allow us to set aside additional money to retire the mortgage held by the bank.

The budget for fiscal year 2023 was submitted to the diocese. It is posted in the commons on the Finance Council bulletin board. I will be updating the budget with actual results concurrently with my quarterly recaps.

On behalf of the finance council thank you for your continued stewardship.

- ⇒ An attitude to just have fun!

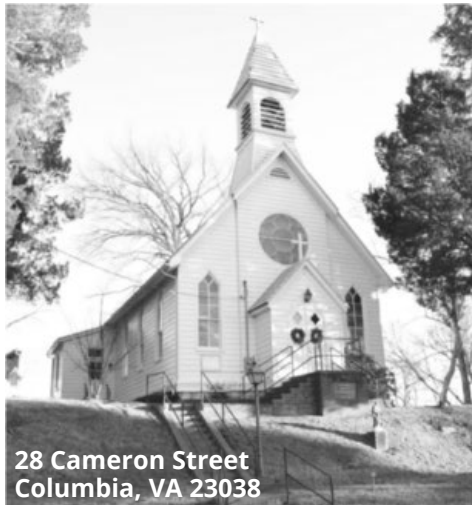

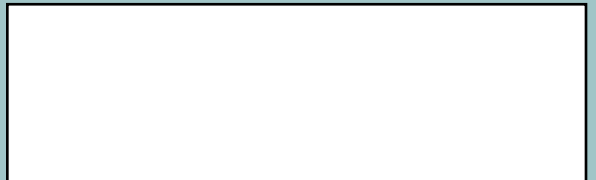
