

Dear Parishioners of Sts. Peter and Paul,

WELCOME TO LENTEN SEASON 2023!

Lent is a very important holy season in the life of our Christian faith and journey. It is time to recalculate; it is time to reposition ourselves along the journey leading us home. I would, therefore, wish to welcome you to this time of grace.

I am asking for your special help this Lent.

Traditionally, this time is marked with an invitation to all Christians to: Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving. I vividly recall the time I have been with you the last three years, how many of you dear parishioners take these three Lenten duties seriously, and I commend you, while I encourage you to keep going!

This Lent, I would like to ask you, yet again, for your help. I would like to bring to your attention what we have had to incur as a parish in terms of unusual but very necessary and significant expenses that total **over \$ 45,000**. Among them, we have updated our water filtration system that has been long overdue for both church and hall at a cost of **\$ 13,105**; we have to clean out 9 septic tanks being estimated at **\$ 10,000**; St. Francis hall stove pilot lights at \$ 1,540; St. Francis ice maker repair at \$ 1,092; Commons HVAC repair at \$ 2,914; 2 Hall HVAC units repair and semi-annual maintenance at \$ **5,918**. Plus, other small expenses, yet very significant and very impactful.

I humbly come to you, asking that this Lent you consider anything you can that will help me defray these necessary expenditures for our parish. Lenten Coin Cans are one way to help, but I fear these repairs require more than what the cans will bring.

I thank you very much for your consideration, while I keep you in my prayers for a fruitful Lent.


STS. PETER & PAUL: FISCAL YEAR-TO-DATE INCOME AND SPENDING (JULY 1, 2022 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2022)

Through the first six months of the fiscal year, Sts. Peter and Paul's budget remained stable: revenue was slightly behind budget, and spending was below budgeted amounts. Our weekly offertory was below budget by 12%. Part of the shortfall was due to Christmas falling on a Sunday. This means there was one less week of collections. Debt reduction has fallen slightly behind budget. Fundraising remains helped to cover a significant portion of the shortfall.

We continue to offset the shortfall in collections with reduced spending. The largest areas of savings are ministries and plant. The savings in ministries is due to the opening in our faith formation ministry. The savings in plant is due to timing differences in the payment of the principal in our long-term debt, not true savings.

Glancing ahead at the rest of the fiscal year there are two significant expenditures which we will incur. We are hiring a person for faith formation, filling a void that has existed for several months. This means we will no longer realize savings on the open position. We are also addressing many maintenance issues that have been deferred for years, for example the problem with our water filtration in both the church and the St. Francis Hall.

As Lent approaches, please consider how you can help meet these needs. And as always, please consider signing up for Faith Direct.



We hope you will one day visit again and probably be interested to partner with us in the task of saving two lives - the mother and child.



- "Shrove Tuesday," better known as Fat Tuesday, is the day before Ash Wednesday which marks the beginning of Lent. Fat Tuesday is about readying oneself for Lent, not just by feasting before a fast, but also a time to reflect, confess and ready one's spirit for the 40 days of repentance that is Lent.
- "To shrive" is to hear confessions. Thus, Shrove Tuesday is a day of feasting as well as penance.
- Since Lent is a period of fasting, on Fat Tuesday, one is supposed to bulk up on fatty, rich foods that are not eaten during Lent. That's one of the reasons pancakes and other fatty foods are traditional fare.
- Mardi Gras means "Fat Tuesday" in French, Fastnacht Day or Fetter Dienstag in German. It's called Pancake Tuesday in England.


